Requirements

Admission to Master 1: completion of a three-year degree programme, i.e. 180 ECTS credits

Admission to Master 2: completion of a four-year degree programme, i.e. 240 ECTS credits

A B2 level in English is required to attend classes.

Selection

Selection after review of the educational file and recruitment interview with the training panel.

Application deadline: from November to March

Interview dates: from February to April
