After your arrival, all students take a French **placement test** in order to be enrolled in the appropriate language level group. Students are prepared for the internationally recognized French examination, the DELF, to be held at the end of the academic year.

- A significant and comprehensive course of French language continues throughout the full year.
- Activities and day trips are also organized in order to discover Rennes and its surroundings.
